THE REPLACEMENT TERMINAL

Why It's Needed

CURRENT TERMINAL:

- Was built in 1930
- 86-year-old building does not meet current earthquake design standards
- Is located too close to the runways by Federal Aviation Administration standards

REPLACEMENT TERMINAL:

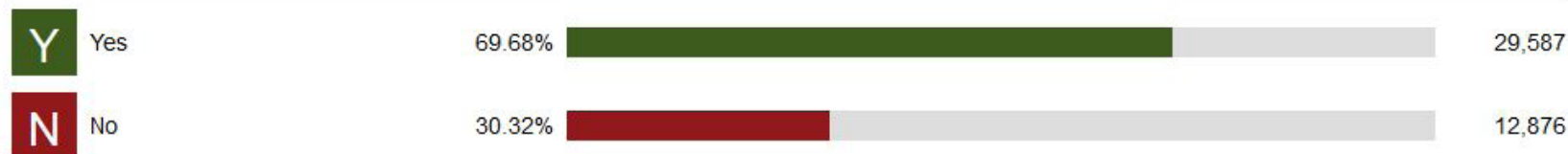
- Will be a 355,000-square-foot facility that will remain 14 gates
- Will meet Federal Aviation Administration runway safety distance standards
- Will meet seismic safety standards
- Will provide increased convenience and accessibility for Airport passengers

THE REPLACEMENT TERMINAL

Measure B Passes

Burbank City Special Municipal Election - Measure B

Shall Ordinance No. 16-3,882 be approved allowing no more than a 14-gate, 355,000 square foot replac...



52 of 52 precincts reporting (100.0%) | Majority of votes cast | Final |

NOVEMBER 8, 2016

Burbank voters approved the passage of Measure B, with nearly 70% of voters in favor of allowing the Airport Authority to build a safer, modern replacement terminal at the Hollywood Burbank Airport.

THE REPLACEMENT TERMINAL

What Did Voters Approve?

BURBANK VOTERS APPROVED

- The right to build a 14-gate, 355,000-square-foot replacement passenger terminal at the Hollywood Burbank Airport
- A Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority governance change that will give Burbank new authority over critical decisions about the Airport's future
- An estimated \$400 million terminal building construction investment in the Burbank community, which will provide a new "front door" for visitors to the surrounding region

THE REPLACEMENT TERMINAL

Where It Will Go



NORTHEAST QUADRANT

The preferred location of the replacement passenger terminal is the B-6 property in the northeast quadrant of the Hollywood Burbank Airport.

AIRPORT ACCESS

The main entrance would be located at the intersection of Hollywood Way and Winona Avenue. An additional entrance would be located off of Cohasset Street.

PUBLIC TRANSIT

A shuttle between the replacement terminal and the Regional Intermodal Transportation Center (RITC) will give passengers access to the rental cars, trains, and buses there.

THE REPLACEMENT TERMINAL

Tasks to Complete

PRE-PLANNING ACTIVITIES (2017)

- Ongoing community outreach
- Soil testing / health risk assessment / geotechnical report
- Update Airport Layout Plan (ALP) and submit for Federal Aviation Administration approval

CONCEPTUAL PLANNING ACTIVITIES (2017-2019)

- Select conceptual planning team
- Public conceptual planning process, with at least six public charrettes in Burbank
- Complete Federal National Environmental Protection Act (NEPA) study

FINANCIAL PLANNING ACTIVITIES (2017-2019)

- Develop financial plan
- Negotiate airline use agreements

THE REPLACEMENT TERMINAL

Tasks to Complete

TERMINAL DESIGN & COMPLETION (2018–2022)

- Complete final design
- Airport Authority approves final design after public hearing
- Submission of plans to City of Burbank for building approval
- Construction
- Open terminal

EXTENSION OF TAXIWAYS (2024)
